Hale's pioneered the concept of "seasonal" beers in the Pacific Northwest way back in 1985 with the initial release of "Wee Heavy Winter Ale". Since then Hale's and the hundreds of craft brewers around the country have produced an incredible array of seasonal and specialty beers. Beyond the beers listed here, Hale's brewers periodically craft even *more* beers, usually in limited batches, as they flex their creative muscles. Ask what may be currently brewing ...

*Hop attributes of Seasonals can vary from year to year as the brewers select the best varieties for each year's edition.*
